Construction Works at King Richard Secondary School

I am writing to provide a further update on the King Richard School construction project.

During this time we will endeavour to make sure that our activities are carried out as considerately as possible to minimise disruption to our neighbours. Furthermore, we will be distributing regular newsletters to keep you up to date on the project progression.



Progress



The structural steel frame installation is now well progressed, as can be seen from the photo adjacent. As the steel frame continues we will begin to install the floors and staircases within the structure. These are pre-cast concrete units which are delivered to site in sections for installation. This reduces the amount of ready mixed concrete that we have to place on site, and the associated deliveries.

Excavation works continue for drainage and external works. To reduce the number of lorry movements to and from site we are

retaining as much of the excavated soil as is possible for re-use in the project.

Out of hours security is in place so that we can monitor the site outside of normal working hours. Our regular meetings with the School continue and we are already beginning to plan with them for the move from the old School into the new.

Whilst we complete the on-site car park we have asked that the site team park with consideration. This work should be completed during October which will allow the site car park to be used. We appreciate your patience during this period.
